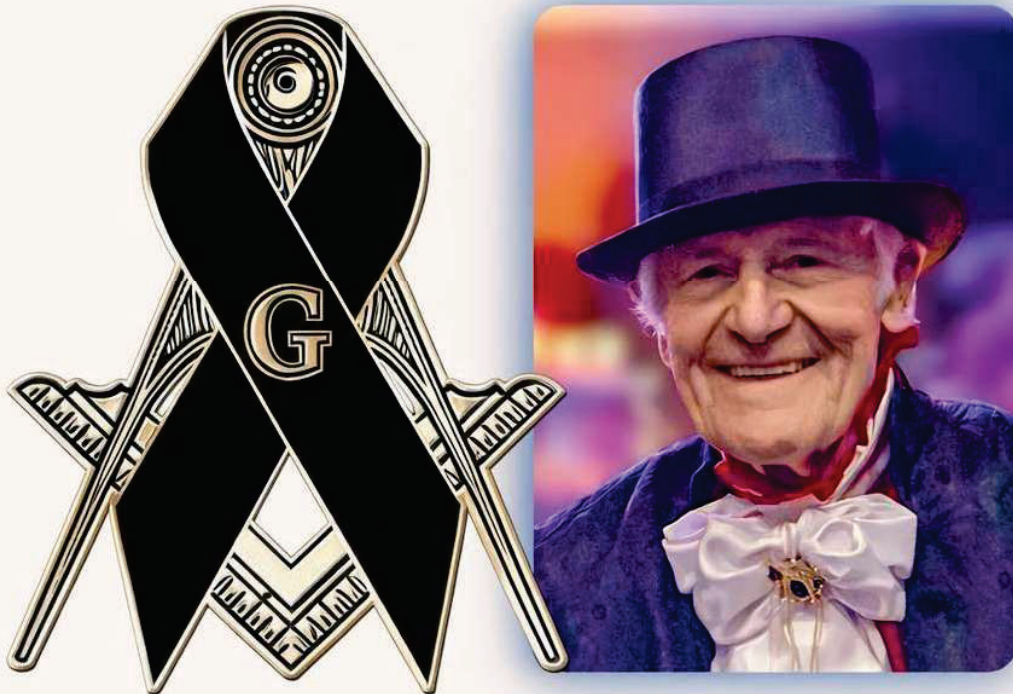

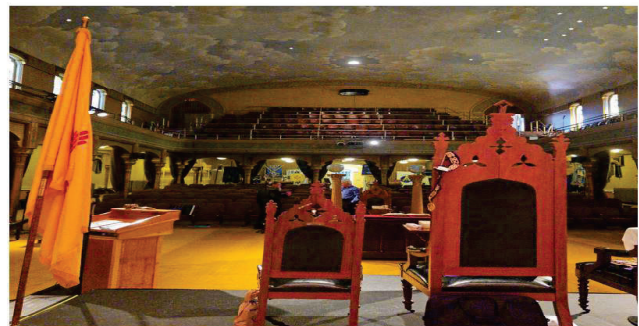

THE ENDURING LIGHT: A MASONIC REFLECTION

WITH MY BACKGROUND AS AN ELECTRICIAN, I'VE ALWAYS HAD A BIT OF AN APPRECIATION FOR THINGS THAT ACTUALLY LAST—ESPECIALLY WHEN IT COMES TO LIGHTING. SO WHEN I CAME ACROSS THE CENTENNIAL LIGHT OUT IN LIVERMORE, CALIFORNIA, IT DEFINITELY CAUGHT MY ATTENTION.

THIS LIGHT BULB HAS BEEN BURNING SINCE 1901. LET THAT SINK IN FOR A SECOND. OVER A HUNDRED YEARS—AND IT'S STILL GOING. NOW SURE, FROM A TECHNICAL STANDPOINT, IT'S INTERESTING. BUT WHAT STOOD OUT TO ME MORE WAS THE LESSON BEHIND IT.

THAT BULB ISN'T BRIGHT LIKE MODERN LIGHTS. IT'S NOT FLASHY. IT DOESN'T TRY TO OUTSHINE EVERYTHING ELSE IN THE ROOM. IT JUST... KEEPS GOING. STEADY. RELIABLE. CONSISTENT. AND HONESTLY, THAT LINES UP PRETTY WELL WITH WHAT WE'RE TAUGHT IN FREEMASONRY.

WE TALK A LOT ABOUT LIGHT—COMING FROM DARKNESS INTO LIGHT, SEEKING MORE LIGHT, ALL OF THAT. BUT IT'S NOT ABOUT HAVING A BURST OF MOTIVATION ONE DAY AND THEN FALLING OFF THE NEXT. IT'S ABOUT SHOWING UP CONSISTENTLY. DOING THE WORK. LIVING OUT THOSE PRINCIPLES DAY BY DAY.

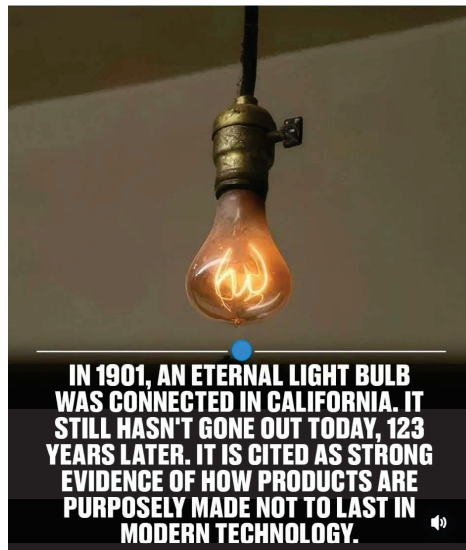
IN MY LINE OF WORK, I'VE SEEN WHAT HAPPENS WHEN THINGS GET PUSHED TOO HARD—THEY BURN OUT. BUT WHEN SOMETHING IS BUILT RIGHT AND USED THE WAY IT'S SUPPOSED TO BE, IT LASTS A LONG TIME.

SAME GOES FOR US.

FREEMASONRY TEACHES US TO KEEP THINGS IN BALANCE. NOT TO BURN OURSELVES OUT, BUT TO STAY STEADY. TO KEEP IMPROVING, A LITTLE AT A TIME, OVER THE LONG HAUL. AND ANOTHER THING—THAT LIGHT DIDN'T MAKE IT THIS FAR ON ITS OWN. IT'S BEEN MAINTAINED AND LOOKED AFTER BY PEOPLE OVER THE YEARS. JUST LIKE THE LODGE. JUST LIKE THE CRAFT. EACH OF US HAS A PART IN KEEPING IT GOING.

SO MAYBE THE TAKEAWAY IS PRETTY SIMPLE: DON'T WORRY ABOUT SHINING THE BRIGHTEST FOR A MOMENT. FOCUS ON BEING STEADY OVER TIME.

BE THE KIND OF LIGHT THAT STICKS AROUND.





WIDOWS SONS MEMORIAL RIDE HONORS LEE TRUITT

THE WIDOWS SONS MRA RECENTLY CAME TOGETHER TO ORGANIZE A MEMORIAL RIDE IN HONOR OF LEE TRUITT, ONE OF THE PILOTS ABOARD THE UPS CARGO PLANE THAT TRAGICALLY CRASHED IN KENTUCKY LAST NOVEMBER. THE EVENT SERVED AS A POWERFUL REMINDER OF THE STRENGTH OF BROTHERHOOD, THE IMPORTANCE OF REMEMBRANCE, AND THE IMPACT A UNITED COMMUNITY CAN HAVE DURING TIMES OF LOSS.

THE DAY BEGAN AT SANDOVAL LODGE, WHERE ENGINES RUMBLED TO LIFE AS APPROXIMATELY 30 MOTORCYCLES GATHERED, JOINED BY SEVERAL ADDITIONAL VEHICLES. RIDERS STOOD SIDE BY SIDE, NOT JUST AS MEMBERS OF THE WIDOWS SONS, BUT AS BROTHERS, FRIENDS, AND MEMBERS OF A COMMUNITY COMMITTED TO HONORING ONE OF THEIR OWN. THERE WAS A QUIET SENSE OF PURPOSE IN THE AIR—THIS WAS MORE THAN JUST A RIDE; IT WAS A TRIBUTE.

FROM THE LODGE, THE GROUP RODE TOGETHER ACROSS TOWN IN A UNIFIED PROCESSION, MAKING THEIR WAY TO THE HOME OF LEE'S FAMILY. THE RIDE ITSELF CARRIED A SYMBOLIC WEIGHT—EACH MILE TRAVELED REPRESENTING RESPECT, REMEMBRANCE, AND THE ENDURING BOND SHARED AMONG THOSE WHO SERVE AND SUPPORT ONE ANOTHER.

UPON ARRIVAL, THE RIDERS WERE MET BY TIFFANY TRUITT, LEE'S WIDOW, ALONG WITH HER FAMILY. IN THE MIDST OF PROFOUND LOSS, TIFFANY GRACIOUSLY OPENED HER HOME AND HER HEART, ALLOWING THOSE GATHERED TO HONOR LEE'S MEMORY IN A DEEPLY PERSONAL WAY. HER STRENGTH AND WILLINGNESS TO SHARE THAT MOMENT WITH THE GROUP DID NOT GO UNNOTICED, AND IT LEFT A LASTING IMPRESSION ON ALL WHO WERE PRESENT. WE ARE TRULY GRATEFUL TO HER FOR ALLOWING US TO REMEMBER LEE NOT JUST AS A NAME, BUT AS A MAN WHOSE LIFE AND LEGACY MATTERED.

THE MEMORIAL BROUGHT TOGETHER NOT ONLY THE WIDOWS SONS, BUT ALSO MEMBERS OF THE WIDER COMMUNITY, DEMONSTRATING HOW FAR-REACHING LEE'S IMPACT WAS. FRIENDS, NEIGHBORS, AND SUPPORTERS STOOD TOGETHER IN SOLIDARITY, REINFORCING THE IDEA THAT NO ONE STANDS ALONE IN TIMES OF HARDSHIP.

ONE OF THE MOST MOVING MOMENTS OF THE DAY CAME WHEN SHAYLIN GOODWIN PERFORMED THE NATIONAL ANTHEM. HER POWERFUL AND HEARTFELT RENDITION BROUGHT A MOMENT OF REFLECTION AND UNITY TO EVERYONE IN ATTENDANCE, SERVING AS A REMINDER OF THE VALUES OF SERVICE, SACRIFICE, AND COUNTRY THAT LEE REPRESENTED.

THROUGHOUT THE GATHERING, STORIES WERE SHARED, MEMORIES WERE HONORED, AND A COLLECTIVE SENSE OF BROTHERHOOD WAS FELT. WHILE THE LOSS OF LEE TRUITT IS DEEPLY FELT, THE OUTPOURING OF SUPPORT MADE IT CLEAR THAT HIS MEMORY WILL CONTINUE TO LIVE ON THROUGH THOSE WHO KNEW HIM, RODE WITH HIM, AND STOOD IN HIS HONOR.

EVENTS LIKE THIS REMIND US THAT FREEMASONRY AND ORGANIZATIONS LIKE THE WIDOWS SONS EXTEND BEYOND MEETINGS AND RIDES—THEY ARE ABOUT SHOWING UP FOR ONE ANOTHER, ESPECIALLY WHEN IT MATTERS MOST. IT IS IN THESE MOMENTS THAT THE TRUE MEANING OF BROTHERHOOD IS REVEALED.

LEE TRUITT'S FINAL FLIGHT MAY HAVE ENDED IN TRAGEDY, BUT HIS LEGACY CONTINUES FORWARD—IN THE HEARTS OF HIS FAMILY, IN THE STRENGTH OF HIS COMMUNITY, AND IN EVERY MILE RIDDEN IN HIS MEMORY.
